

Art Squared Auction 2023

Information and Agreement for Artists

The Art Squared Silent Auction will be held in conjunction with Heritage Day, a fundraiser for the Friends of Historic Spring City. It will be held on Saturday, **May 27, 2023** in Spring City. Please read the following information and sign below indicating you agree to the terms listed:

- Artists can submit a limit of **two square paintings** for the in person auction. (The number is now limited to leave enough space for all the artists involved.)
- Artists can submit **two additional square painting for an online-only auction** that will run for a month beyond Heritage Day. This will be a good way to connect with collectors who can't make it to Spring City in person.
- The works submitted for the art squared auction must be original, unframed, and on MDF or other suitable material (12" x 12"). Art can be delivered on the afternoon of Friday, May 26 (or the morning of the show before 9 am) to the 2nd floor of the City Building. Other delivery points outside of Spring City will be available before Wednesday May 24.
- 50% of the proceeds of the art squared pieces will go to the artist and 50% to the Friends of Historic Spring City. Payment will be issued within 30 days of the event.
- Each participating artist may bring up to **three** additional framed, ready-to-hang paintings to display and sell. Each piece must be identified and priced by the artist (bringing your own tags with name, title and price). A 20% commission will be charged for these works—with the artist keeping the other 80%. Because of limited wall space, please avoid bringing especially large paintings.
- Art Squared paintings will be sold by silent bids. Minimum bid amounts must be set by the artist or agent of the artist. Otherwise, a \$75 minimum bid will be set. Any unsold art will be returned to the artist.
- **This form must be adhered to the back of each entry; all artists must also adhere a W9 form to the back of the paintings as well.**
- We will not be able to insure the work. Insurance must be carried by the artist if desired. Artists will be responsible for reporting their own income, as the sales do not qualify as charitable donations.
- No unsold paintings from previous years will be accepted for the auction or show. The organizers reserve the right to reject pieces with subject matter inappropriate for the show; that are too large; or that are not properly prepared for display/hanging.
